

# United Community Action Network "Oasis Skate Park" Release, Covenant Not To Sue, and Indemnity Agreement

I understand that skateboarding and similar activities are inherently dangerous and I understand those dangers. I also understand that participation in and use of the Oasis Skate Park involves risks of significant injury. These risks include equipment problems or failures, contact with and actions of other facility users, slips/trips/falls, and musculoskeletal or head injuries, among others. I choose for myself or for my child to use the Oasis Skate Park despite the risks.

By signing this form, I acknowledge all risks of injury, illness and death and affirm that I have assumed responsibility of injury, illness and death in any way connected with use of the Oasis Skate Park facility.

I have read the rules and regulations for the Oasis Skate Park. I agree for myself and for any child participant to follow all rules and regulations, including those posted at the facility.

In return for the opportunity to use the facility, I agree for myself and for my heirs, assigns, executors and administrators to release, waive, and discharge any legal rights I may have to seek payment or relief of any kind from United Community Action Network, Oasis Skate Park, its employees, volunteers, or its agents for injury, illness or death resulting from or connected with the use of the facility.

If I am registering a child for facility use, I agree that I am a parent, legal guardian, or am otherwise responsible for the child whose application I am submitting and that I release, waive, and discharge any legal rights that I may assert on behalf of the child participating in use of the Oasis Skate Park facility. I also agree not to sue United Community Action Network, its employees, volunteers, or its agents and agree to indemnify United Community Action Network for all claims, damages, losses or expenses including attorney fees, if a suit is filed concerning an injury, illness or death to me or to my child resulting from or connected with facility use.

## ***Oasis Skate Park Rules and Regulations***

\*Please initial by each statement showing that you have read, understand and will abide to each rule and regulation.

1. USE OF FACILITY IS AT YOUR OWN RISK. The facility is used by both experienced and inexperienced skateboard riders and inline skaters. Serious injury may occur from colliding with other riders, falling on the skate surfaces, and flying objects. United Community Action Network does not assume responsibility for any injuries. \_\_\_\_\_

2. ALL PERSONS ARE REQUIRED TO HAVE A SIGNED WAIVER before using the skate park. It must be completed and returned to United Community Action Network. Children under 18 years old must have a parent/legal guardian sign their waiver. \_\_\_\_\_

3. Inspect surfaces before you ride. Do not ride damaged, rocky, wet or icy surfaces. Report any damages to ramps or skating surface and other maintenance issues to United Community Action Network at 661-948-3000. \_\_\_\_\_

4. The skate park is to be used as designed. Make no modifications to the skate surface or features. Outside ramps, jumps or obstacles within the skate park are prohibited. \_\_\_\_\_

5. Drug use/possession and alcohol consumption is prohibited. \_\_\_\_\_

6. No abusive language or loud music is allowed within the skate park. \_\_\_\_\_

7. Glass is not allowed inside the park. \_\_\_\_\_

8. United Community Action Network reserves the right to change the hours of operation. \_\_\_\_\_

9. Facility users are subject to spot checks by United Community Action Network staff for compliance with it skate park rules and regulations. \_\_\_\_\_

10. The operating hours of the Oasis Skate Park are as follows: 10 a.m. – 2 p.m. Monday through Friday. \_\_\_\_\_

11. United Community Action Network reserves the right to refuse service to anyone. \_\_\_\_\_

### ***Rule Violation Policy***

\*Please initial by each statement showing that you have read, understood and agreed to each violation policy.

Any violation of skate park rules may result in the following:

1. Verbal warning will be given for the following examples (but not limited to): Glass inside the skate park, loud music, or abusive language. \_\_\_\_\_

2. Asked to leave the park for remainder of the day (and parents called if under 18). For example but not limited to: No waiver signed by patron or parent/guardian, at the skate park after hours of operation or before. If a patron refuses to leave, the police will be called and notice of trespass will be issued. \_\_\_\_\_

3. For severe offenses, such as, but not limited to fighting, theft, graffiti, vandalism, possession of weapons or drugs, server verbal threats, or sexual misconduct, the participant will be suspended from the skate park. If the patron refuses to leave, the police will be called. \_\_\_\_\_
